The Men's Referral Service is a men's family violence telephone counselling, information and referral service and is the central point of contact for men taking responsibility for their violent and abusive behaviour.

The Men's Referral Service is staffed by trained counsellors who will listen to you, find out more about your situation and give you the advice and support you need.

When you call the Men's Referral Service:

- You will talk with a trained counsellor
- You will be treated with respect and without judgement
- You don't need to give your name.
